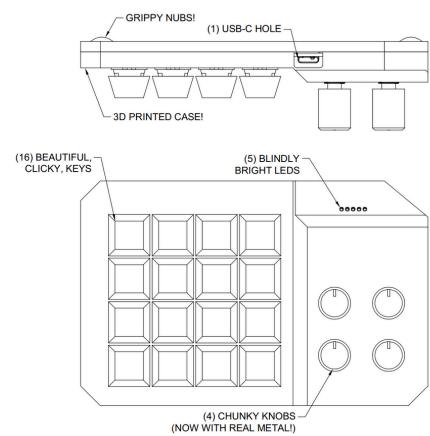




first of all, thanks. second of all, I hope you like it. third of all, here's how to get started:



Step 1. Unbox your JankDek.

Step 2. Get a USB to USB-C cable and connect your JankDek to your computer. Feel the power.

Step 3. Download Vial from here: get.vial.today

Vial is how you separate the Jank from the Dek. This is where you can assign keys, create macros, and really unlock the full potential that JankDek has to offer.

Step 4. Check it out! Your JankDek is aliiiiive. You should see a representation of the jankdek in the app. You can click on each button in the graphic, then assign a key to it through the large, large selection of options in the lower section.

The LEDs on the jankdek indicate power (far left) and active layer (the rest). Play with the layers, you'll figure it out.

Now, the world is your Dek. Here's some ideas to get you started:

- Map media control keys
- Create text chat macros
- Use the magical F13-F24 keys to control scenes or volumes in OBS
- Bind a soundboard
- Bind every key to "Power off PC"
- Explore all the possibilities of QMK
- Create custom keybinds in your favorite CAD program

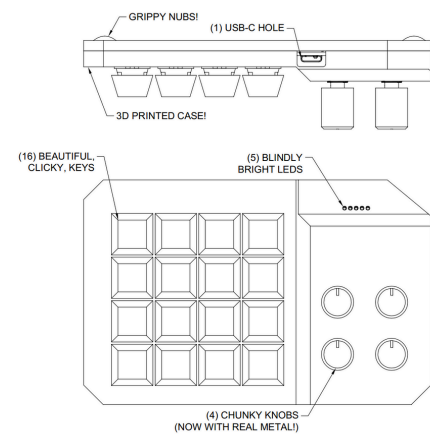
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
